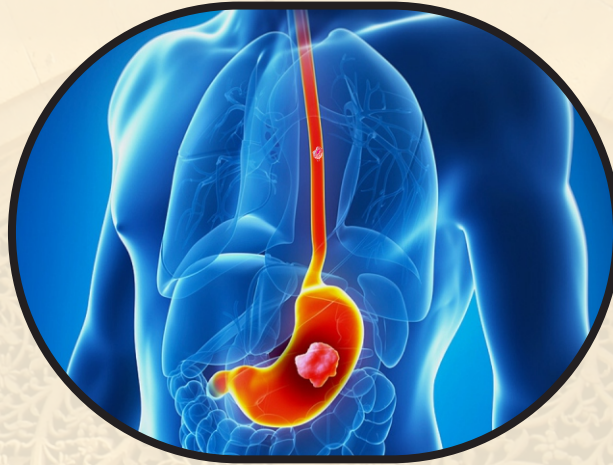

# ABOUT AHMEDABAD



## **THE GANDHI ASHRAM :**

The Gandhi Ashram situated alongside the Sabarmati River, was the nerve centre for the Indian Freedom movement.

## **SIDI SAYED JALI :**

This elegant mosque is noted for its twin windows of pierced stone, worked in style of a tree with palm leaves and curving tendrils. A superb and peerless example of delicate carving that transforms stone into filigree.



## **JAMA MASJID :**

Located in the centre of the old city, this congregation mosque was built by Sultan Ahmed Shah in 1423.

## **SABARMATI RIVERFRONT :**

Sabarmati Riverfront is a waterfront being developed along the banks of Sabarmati river in Ahmedabad, India. The major objectives of project are environment improvement, social infrastructure and sustainable development.



## **KANKARIA LAKE :**

It is another tourist attraction of Ahmedabad. The Kankaria Lake is a circular lake constructed in AD 1451 by Sultan Qutub-ud-din. Mini Train, Kids City, Balvatika, Jaldhara Water Park, Zoo, Helium balloon ride (Ahmedabad Eye) are the major attractions.

## **SARKHEJ ROZA :**

The Sarkhej Roza is graceful architectural creation, amazing for the use of pierced stone trellises and complete absence of arches.





# ABOUT GUJARAT



## AKSHARDHAM TEMPLE, GANDHINAGAR :

It is one of the largest temples in the state of Gujarat. The temple complex combines devotions, art, architecture, education exhibition and research at one place. There is a fascinating laser light show, a fusion of high-end-technology and is exhibited on the giant water screen primarily consisting of water droplets.

## DWARKA :

Turn back the cosmic clock, let your imagination plummet suddenly into 1500 BC, and you may begin to recreate in your mind's eye, a city of gold – Dwarka, the mesmerizing kingdom of Lord Krishna. Located at the western tip of the Saurashtra peninsula, this town enjoys remarkable importance in Hindu lore. It is the only place considered both one of the four principal holy places (char dham), as well as one of the seven ancient towns (sapta puris) to visit.



## GIR NATIONAL PARK :

The Gir Forest National Park and Wildlife Sanctuary is a forest and wildlife sanctuary in Gujarat, India. Established in 1965, with a total area of 1412km<sup>2</sup>(about 258 km<sup>2</sup> for the fully protected area( The National Park) and 1153 km<sup>2</sup> for the Sanctuary),the park is located about 365 kilometres south west of Ahmedabad and is well connected by road.

## SAFED RANN OF KUTCH:

The Great Rann of Kutch is a seasonal salt marsh located in the Thar Desert in the Kutch District of Gujarat. It is about 7,505.22 square kilometres (2,897.78 sq mi) in size and is reputed to be one of the largest salt deserts in the world. The spectacular sight of boundless white desert under the moonlight presents the stunning creation of nature, unique to this world.



## SOMNATH TEMPLE :

Shree Somnath Mahadev temple is built at the shore of the Arabian sea on the western corner of Indian subcontinent. This pilgrimage is one of the oldest and finds its reference in the ancient texts like Skandpuran, ShreemadBhagvat, Shivpuran etc. Somnath is at a distance 465 km from Ahmedabad and is well connected to Ahmedabad by road.
